Resumé of Ms Kerstin Lundgren

Kerstin Lundgren was elected as Third Deputy Speaker of the Swedish Parliament in 2018 and re-elected in 2022. She represents the Centre Party and has been a member of the Swedish Parliament since 2002.

Kerstin Lundgren is a member of the Committee on Foreign Affairs and has been the Centre Party’s foreign policy spokesperson since 2006. She is a member of the Swedish delegation to the NATO Parliamentary Assembly. She has previously been a member of the Committee on the Constitution and also a deputy member of the Committee on Defence and the Committee on EU affairs. She was a member of the Swedish delegation to the Council of Europe in 2007–2018 where she was Deputy Chair of the Alliance of Liberals and Democrats for Europe (ALDE).

Kerstin Lundgren holds a Bachelor degree in Political Science from Uppsala University and has a particular interest in international relations, security policy, constitutional matters and climate policy. She has been a member of the Commission on the Constitution, a member of the board of Sida and a member of the Advisory Council for the Folke Bernadotte Academy. She was a member of the National Board of the Centre Party for seven years and Chair of the Centre Party in the Stockholm region for 10 years.

The Riksdag is Sweden’s supreme decision-making assembly. Its 349 members are chosen in general elections every 4 years. The Speaker is the foremost representative of the Riksdag.
